

On 4th September 2023, the Government of Belize officially inaugurated the ICC which was approved by the Cabinet (Cabinet Paper No. 181 of 2022) on 22nd November 2022.

Enhance the GOB's overall capacity to develop, coordinate, manage, and monitor financial and technical assistance.


